What is NFC?



NFC is a “touch-to-connect” technology that enables quick information exchange.

Simply tap your smartphone or an NFC reader on the tag to open a URL, display a message, or trigger various actions.

From POP displays and events to digital business cards, NFC offers endless possibilities depending on your ideas.

How NFC Can Be Used

Guide users to special websites by placing NFC tags on posters



Embed NFC in employee IDs or business cards to create digital business cards



Integrate NFC into apparel tags to share brand stories or care instructions



Replace QR codes for event reception or attendee check-in



Simple NFC Setup

1. Prepare a rewritable NFC tag and an NFC-enabled smartphone, then install a dedicated NFC app.

※The NFC chip embedded in the TENTAC NFC Memo Pad is locked by default, and its content cannot be rewritten.

2. Open the app and enter the information you want to write.

3. Tap your smartphone on the NFC tag to transfer the data.

4. Confirm that the written information works correctly.
